

Carto 2007 Accomodation Information - Bishop Mountain Residences

Bishop Mountain Residences, at 3935 University St. at the edge of beautiful Mount Royal Park within a 15 minute walk (approx.) of downtown. The residence is north of Pine Avenue and University St.

Most of our rooms are singles (one person per room). They share bathroom and kitchen facilities with the other rooms on the floor. (Pots/pans, plates, cutlery etc. are not provided). Included in the rooms are: linen, soap and towels. The rooms themselves are not air-conditioned, however, our front office rents out fans, kettles and irons. We do have a small number of double rooms available (these too share bathrooms with the other rooms on the floor). There are no telephones provided in the rooms however there are payphones located in the lobby of each residence. There are computers with free access to internet in the lobby of the residences main office.
