- **Reproduction Policy.** A “Permissions Policy for Facsimile Reproduction” was finalized and approved by the Executive.
- **ACMLA Publications Document.** A new Publications Document has been drafted encompassing all of the separate ACMLA publications policies and more. Separate policies now included in the new document include: “Permissions Policy for Facsimile Reproduction”, the “Official Languages” Policy, and the “ACMLA Bulletin Open Access” policy. This new Publications Document will be available on the ACMLA website for further discussion at the 2009 AGM.
